# Packing Guide

## What's Included

- Expert field guides
- Two nights accommodation at Arkaba Homestead, a Luxury Lodges of Australia property
- Two nights signature swag bush camping (canvas swag protector, mattress and pillow provided)
- Fully inclusive meals - all meals, beverages and trails snacks included
- 65L duffle bag, to pack your overnight personal items each day
- 30L day pack, with 2L hydration reservoir and room for personal items
- Sock guard gaiters
- Walking poles
- Essential toiletries, including body, hand wash, shampoo and conditioner
- Head torch
- Stainless steel water bottles
- Bath towel
- Fly nets
- Arkaba Conservation Levy

\*We undertake robust cleaning practices after each walk. If you're not comfortable using shared equipment, you are welcome to bring your own items ie water bottle, back pack, walking poles & gaiters.

## Power And Phones

Mobile service coverage is not available at Arkaba Conservancy. Guides have phones that can be used if necessary. There is no power at the bush camps so please make sure cameras are fully charged and spare batteries packed if necessary. We recommend bringing your own solar power bank.

## Your Guide Will Carry

- Satellite phone and navigation aid for emergency use
- Hand-held UHF radio for communication
- First aid kit
- Species Guides, for flora & fauna identification

## What To Bring

- Well worn-in walking boots with good ankle support and good tread (sandshoes and trainers are not recommended for walking)
- Lightweight shoes/sandals for wear at the bush camps (when not walking) and at Arkaba Homestead
- Smart casual attire for your evenings at Arkaba Homestead
- Long pants (ideally from a quick dry material - not heavy denim)
- Shorts
- Light wicking shirts (with SPF recommended) or light cotton shirts, preferably long sleeve
- Socks and underwear
- Warm clothing, including beanie or woolly hat, gloves, thermals, scarf and fleece
- Waterproof windcheater
- Wide-brimmed hat, sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Small personal aid kit including blister protection
- Camera and spare batteries
- Power bank - solar powered
- Binoculars optional for wildlife and bird viewing
- Swimming costume to use Arkaba Homestead's outdoor pool
- Personal medications
